REQUIREMENTS

- A student, who is currently a sophomore or junior with a 2.5 or higher GPA, and is in good academic standing as of January 1, 2015.
- Demonstration of leadership potential (i.e. involvement in student government, community leadership or similar activities).
- Current high school transcript.
- Two letters of recommendation. One letter must be from a school official and one from a community member who is not related to you.
- Essay (2 required).
- All agreements (please see website).

The **African-American Leaders for Tomorrow (AALT) Program** is a four-day long residential summer program that is held on the campus of California State University Dominguez Hills (CSUDH). Sixty students are hand selected and receive leadership training and attend workshops on topics such as college experience, career development and financial literacy. Students live on campus at CSUDH. Housing, meals, program materials, as well as transportation during the conference will be provided at no cost to the participants; and for students living outside of Los Angeles county transportation to the conference will also be provided.

DEADLINES

- **March 9, 2015** - Applications will be available.
- **June 5, 2015** - Application deadline.
- **June 8, 2015 through June 12, 2015** - Review and Selection Process.
- **June 15, 2015** - Students will be notified.
- **July 29 – August 1, 2015** - The conference will be held on the campus of CSUDH.

Students will need spending money for snacks, souvenirs, etc.

Travel arrangements will be made for students living outside of Los Angeles County. Conference participants will stay in campus housing and be supervised at all times.
